Dear Husker Refuse Family,

We are grateful for the opportunity to serve you and our entire community. We feel it is important to address you directly regarding the violations we have received from Nebraska State Patrol. The violations were due to the registered weight of our trucks being too low for the weight of our loads. The violations occurred from July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. In April of this year we were notified by Nebraska States Patrol about an investigation they conducted by subpoenaing our landfill records for the above dates.

Once we were made aware of the registered weight violations we took immediate action to increase the registered weight of our trucks. Registered weight is a sticker that is placed on our license plate; they are purchased at the department of licensing similar to the annual tabs for all vehicles. If Nebraska State Patrol informed us of these violations during roadside contact, we would have complied sooner. The communication from Nebraska State Patrol did not take place until 385 violations had occurred. We also want to make it clear these violations were not safety related. Since we took immediate action to correct these violations, the fine was reduced by 25%. We are looking forward to donating \$57,131.25 to the great State of Nebraska. Thank you again for the opportunity to serve you weekly for years to come.
